Your 2019 NOMAR Dues have been invoiced. Dues are payable now, and become delinquent on December 1, 2018. The following delinquent fees apply: Dec  $1^{st}$  = \$50, Jan  $1^{st}$  = \$75, Feb  $1^{st}$  = \$100.

If you are going inactive, please advise us in writing; we cannot terminate membership, nor refund NOMAR or GSREIN Dues without written notification. In order to refund 2019 NOMAR dues, your license must be updated at LREC and a refund request in writing must be received no later than December 27, 2018. In order to refund GSREIN dues, your license must be updated at LREC and a refund request in writing must be received no later than January 14, 2019. GSREIN refunds are only issued the week of January 14<sup>th</sup> and cannot be issued after this date. A \$25 processing fee will be deducted from all refunds.
